LOCATION OF THE COLLEGE

Bhergaon College is presently situated in a beautiful scenic place of Mahaliapara near sericulture office, half a kilometer away from Bhergaon centre assesible from all directions.

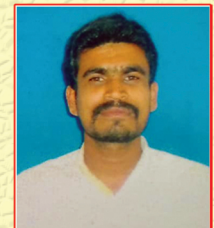
